



Below given are a list of scholarships that cover up to 100% tuition fees and more.

1) Chevening scholarships

- This is one of the most respected scholarships in the UK which covers tuition fees, living expenses and air ticket. You need to apply for the scholarship one year before your intake. For example, if your intake is September 2023, you have to submit your application on 2022 before deadline
- Deadline – Opens on August every year and closes on November first week
- Qualification – Bachelor's Degree plus 2 years work experience
- Shortlisting Criteria – Excellent Overall Profile
- Documentation – Unconditional offer letter, IELTS, final marksheets and all work experience documents, references
- Interview will be conducted between February and April at British Embassy and High Commission. Results will be published on June
- Note: If you don't have all the documents during time of application, still you can apply. Although you have to submit it by the time of interview.

2) Commonwealth scholarships

- Only available for Masters and PhD students from Commonwealth countries like India. It is a need-based scholarship. Awarded to 800 students each year. It covers tuition fees and living expenses.
- Note. Requires nomination from External Scholarships Division of Ministry of HR Development, India.
- Only for Master's students, MBA students cannot apply
- Deadline – December 22nd
- Qualification – Bachelor's Degree plus relevant experience
- Selection Criteria – Academic Merit, Development Impact, Quality of study plans
- Documentation –final marksheets, all work experience documents, references

3) International Development Full Fee Scholarship at University of East Anglia

- Only for students who apply for Master's programme at University of East Anglia. It covers tuition fees. For students who want to pursue Master's in Education, Development Economics, Education Leadership, Agricultural and Rural Development, Climate Change, Gender Analysis, Social Development and International Relations
- Deadline – Unavailable
- Qualification – Bachelor's Degree 65%
- Documentation –final marksheets, 250 words scholarship statement, references



4) Reach Oxford Scholarships

- Only for students who apply for Bachelor's programme at University of Oxford. Covers tuition fees, living expenses and return air tickets for every year for the entire duration of the course.
- Deadline – February every year
- Requirements – Full offer letter from Oxford, Academic ability and financial need

5) Developing Solutions Masters Scholarships

- Only for students who apply for Master's programme at University of Nottingham. Waivers 50 to 100 percent tuition fees. Awarded to 105 students each year.
- Requirements – Full offer letter from Nottingham
- Note. You can apply University of Nottingham's online portal under scholarships section. You'll have to provide your achievements, study plan and reason for choosing to study at Nottingham.
- Only for Master's students, MBA students cannot apply
- Deadline – May 20th
